### The proposal process

All exhibition proposals are considered by the Pātaka Art + Museum Exhibitions Committee. The committee endeavours to present a balanced and varied exhibition programme, representing a range of media, cultures and interests.

The exhibition programme for Bottle Creek and Toi Gallery is finalised up to one year in advance. The Exhibitions Committee meets to consider proposals twice per year. Please check our website for the current proposal rounds.

## **Bottle Creek Gallery**

Bottle Creek Gallery is Pātaka's community gallery. The gallery is predominantly used for local artists and groups, but also for exhibitions that reflect Porirua. The gallery has 32 linear metres of wall space which can be extended by the use of movable walls and 130m2 in floor area. Please refer to floor plan on *page 8*.

- · There is no rental fee for local artists and groups
- Works don't have to be for sale but if they are,
  Pātaka charges a 35% commission on all sold works
- · Exhibitions run for 5-6 weeks

## **Toi Gallery**

Toi Gallery is Pātaka's commercial gallery where we exhibit and sell work from local, national and international artists. The gallery has 32 linear metres and 60m2 in floor space. It can be accessed through the Toi Store and from the main galleries. Please refer to floor plan on *page 9*.

- There is a \$100 per week gallery rental cost for exhibiting in the Toi Gallery
- Works displayed in this gallery must be for sale.
  Pātaka charges a 35% commission on all sales
- Exhibitions run for 5-6 weeks

## Main Exhibition Galleries

These are divided into three different galleries, ranging from the smallest at 32 linear metres, to the largest space of 60+ linear metres. The exhibitions in these spaces are mainly curated in-house by Pātaka's curatorial team. Galleries are also used for touring exhibitions, both national and international. Programmes are usually scheduled between 1 - 2 years in advance.
